2013 Annual Wage and Job Growth Survey

After ten years of conducting an **Annual Wage and Job Growth Survey**, the 2013 results are in and again, they are terrific. Charleston's knowledge based companies averaged an annual wage of \$71,657, a number 1.85 and 1.74 times the State and Charleston metro region averages, respectively. Beyond wages, hiring remains strong with tech companies gobbling up ever more real estate in the Charleston market.

CODEcamp v.2 - Talent

Rather than just talking about needing more talent, we filled the prescription in May 2012 by launching **CODEcamp** and continuing to improve the program based on student feedback.
